In hiring Mr. Menchaca, the District's Board of Trustees, recognized that his leadership experience would complement the work and success the district has already set into motion. His 21 years of educational experience include special education, coaching, serving as assistant principal and serving as campus principal. He brings ten years of administrative leadership experience to the district.
